MINUTES

Town Council Work Session
Monday, May 17th, 2021 at 6:00 pm

The media and public were duly notified of the date, time, and place of this meeting. A quorum was present.

COUNCIL PRESENT: Mayor Michael Bishop, Mayor Pro Tem Juston Ricard, Councilmembers Fecas, Hallman, Hook, Reeley and Wilkerson.

COUNCIL ABSENT: None.

STAFF PRESENT: Administrator Ashley Watkins, Municipal Clerk Leeann Eden, Chief of Police Andrew Richbourg, Captain Chris Manuel, Attorney Sierra Carini

I. Call to Order

Mayor Bishop called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. A quorum was present. Councilmember Hallman provided the invocation. Mayor Bishop led the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. Consent Agenda

Council unanimously approved the May 17th, 2021 Work Session Agenda.

III. Items for Discussion

- A. Commercial Vehicle Parking. Council agreed to postpone discussion until after legal advice is obtained from Attorney Bradley at the next meeting.
- B. Tree Preservation. Administrator Watkins gave background information on the Tree Preservation guidelines. Mayor Bishop inquired about how the proposed ordinance would affect landowners in Town. There was discussion on how to avoid the ordinance being a hindrance to land and home owners. Council agreed that the proposed ordinance should be focused on new development. Mayor Pro Tem Ricard inquired about the County land disturbance permit process. Administrator Watkins stated that she would reach out to Sheri Armstrong with Lexington County Land Development for further clarification.

IV. Town Council Reports

- A. Parrish Plantation. Councilmember Fecas discussed a follow-up meeting with DHEC concerning Parrish Plantation Pond scheduled for Thursday, May 20th, 2021 at 1:00 pm.
- B. DOT. Mayor Bishop informed Council that he reported a culvert on Shampy Street that had been hit by a vehicle.
- C. Elected Officials. Councilmember Fecas inquired about discussion for the American Rescue Recovery funds, stating that there needs to be a plan in place. Mayor Bishop requested the topic to be added to the next Work Session for discussion. Administrator Watkins stated that it is her understanding the funds would have to be applied to future projects, and would not be applicable to current projects.

Council, on motion of Councilmember Hook, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Ricard, voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 6:43 p.m.
