



MINUTES

Town Council Work Session
Monday, June 15th, 2026 at 6:00 pm

The media and public were duly notified of the date, time, and place of this meeting.

COUNCIL PRESENT: Mayor Juston Ricard, Mayor Pro Tem Wilkerson, Councilmembers Fecas, Wilbourne, Hallman, and Reeley.

COUNCIL ABSENT: Councilmember Cory Hook.

STAFF PRESENT: Town Administrator Ashley Watkins, Chief of Police Andrew “Bear” Richbourg.

1. Call to Order

Mayor Ricard called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. A quorum was present. Councilmember Hallman provided the invocation, and Mayor Ricard led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Consent Agenda

A. FY 2026-2027 Budget. Administrator Watkins stated there were no changes to the budget since first reading was held. There was a discussion of budgetary items, including the cost for repairs and the purchase of a garbage truck. Councilmember Fecas stated she has been speaking with residents about the millage increase, and has received no negative feedback.

4. Reports

A. Elected Officials. Registration for the Municipal Association’s Annual Meeting in Greenville has been completed. Councilmember Fecas informed Council of the Municipal Association’s Small Cities Summit being held on August 12th. Mayor Ricard, Mayor Pro Tem Wilkerson, and Councilmember Hallman expressed interest in attending.

C. Town Parks – Wilkerson. Administrator Watkins is to reach out to West Columbia Administrator Brian Carter to continue discussions on a partnership for the splash pad. Council requested a list of quotes previously received for the installation of a well.

D. Community Relations/Education – Fecas. Councilmember Fecas reported that as a result of new legislation, the Lexington County Council will no longer operate as the County Transportation Committee body. Legislative delegations are now authorized to appoint CTC members. All members must be residents of the county they serve. Councilmember Fecas proposed hosting a hot dog lunch in the Cottages at Roof’s Pond neighborhood after summer.
